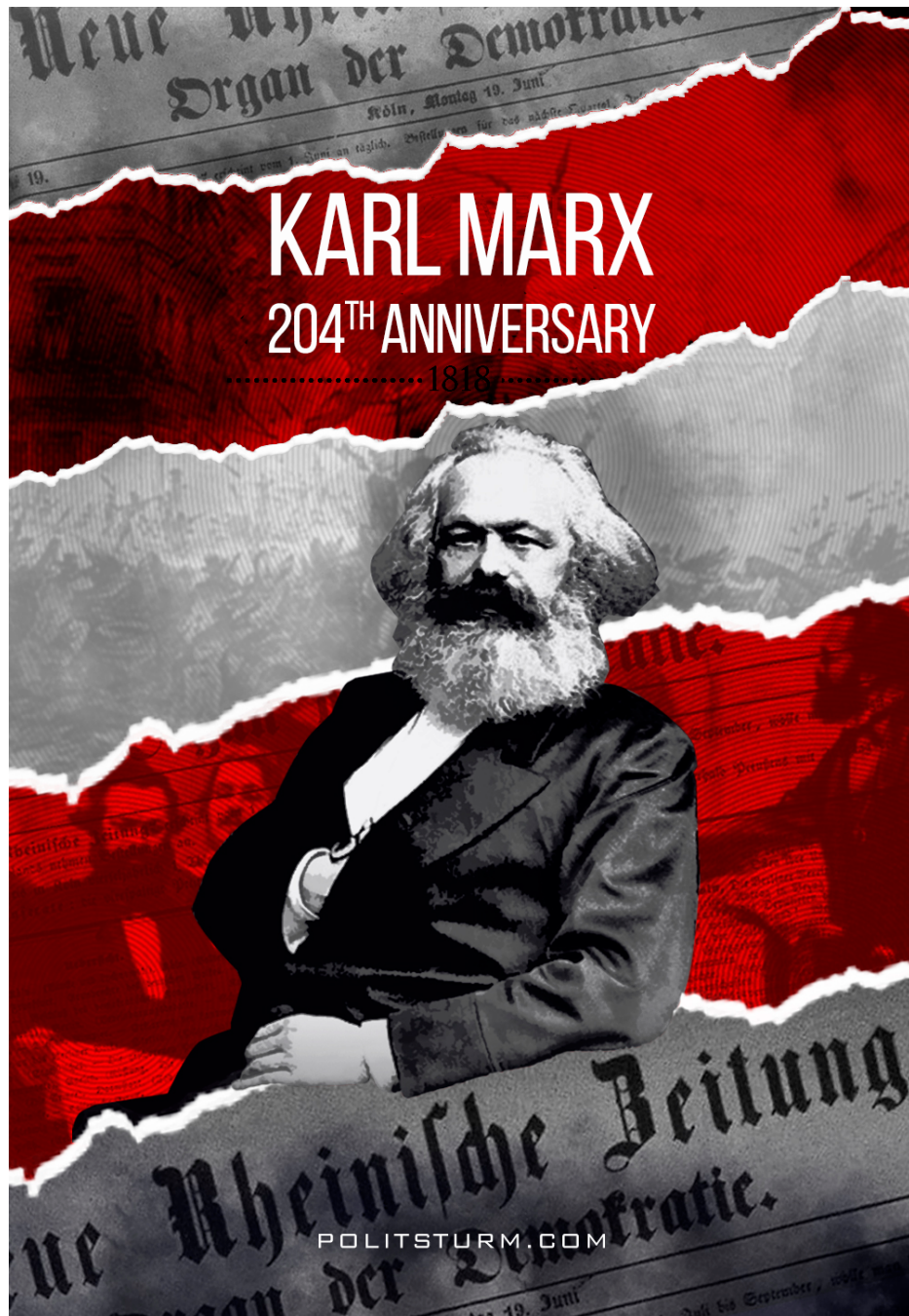


Karl Marx - 204th Anniversary
