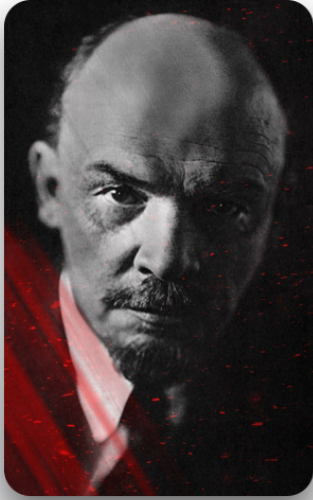


Lenin on the Revolutionary
